Making the Right Subject Choices:

- Select one subject from each block and do not choose the same subject in more than one block.
- It is compulsory to choose a minimum of one science subject as part of your options. All students study one science subject in Key Stage 4.
- Arabic students must choose to study either Ministry Arabic 1 or GCSE Arabic (First Language). Arabic students cannot enter for GCSE Arabic (Second Language) whilst following the MOE&HE curriculum.
- English will be taught as a single subject. Some students will be entered for two GCSEs, English Language and English Literature. Some students will be entered for English Language only. This will be decided in Year 11.
- Subject choices should not be based on friends decision or the perceived ease of a subject.
- Consider your strengths & interests, teacher advice and career aspirations when making decisions about your options.
- All completed forms must be completed, signed and handed to the form tutor by the **26th February 2026**.
