Essential Duties & Responsibilities



- Ensure that planning is shared in a timely manner for other teachers on the school SharePoint.
- Ensure weekly communication to parents about the learning is timely.
- Utilise various teaching methodologies and integrate technology to encourage student engagement and facilitate learning.

Assessment and Reporting

- Regularly evaluate student performance through formal and informal assessments.
- Provide constructive feedback and work with students to set goals for language improvement.
- Maintain accurate records of student progress and report to parents and school administration in a timely manner. These will be in line with the Ministry of Education.
- Adapt teaching methods based on assessment outcomes to meet the individual learning needs of students.

Curriculum Development

- Collaborate with other team members to develop an integrated curriculum aligning with the Qatar Ministry of Education (MoE).
- Incorporate elements of Qatari culture, history, and current events into the curriculum to create a wellrounded learning experience.

- Implement classroom rules and disciplinary measures in a fair and consistent manner.
- Address any behavioural or academic issues promptly and in accordance with OIS behaviour policies.
