In Asia, Kyushu University welcomed an incredibly talented Oryx graduate to study Electrical Engineering and Computer Science under a full scholarship, which includes a monthly living allowance and return flights for the start and end of the course. While we were also delighted to hear that one of our students has now begun their university studies at the University of Nottingham, a proud Russell Group member, in Ningbo, China.

Meanwhile in The Americas and Canada, the University of Toronto warmly welcomed a further two Oryx graduates, the first to study Biochemistry and the other who is now studying Social Sciences. In parallel, the University of Palermo in Argentina, welcomed an Oryx graduate to undertake their university Degree in Sound Design and Music Production earlier this month.

In Oceania, the academic year runs January to December, so while some of graduates have Offers to attend some prestigious institutions, including the University of Queensland, where one Oryx Graduate plans to study Law, and the second Mechanical and Aerospace Engineering; paperwork is currently being finalised to conclude their applications or scholarships.

Ensuring Oryx graduates are well informed about the future possibilities that lie before them, is the responsibility of Mr Amaso, the school's University & Careers Lead. Mr Amaso begins working with the students in Year 09, the final stage of Key Stage 3, as the students diligently prepare and take their first steps into tailoring their school studies, all of which will later lay the foundation stones for their University Degree course.

In Key Stage 4 – Years 10 and 11 – as the students sit their IGCSE exams, they are required to choose a series of optional elective subjects, to compliment the mandatory subjects of English, Maths and Science. These exams are the precursor to the student's working with Mr Amaso and the wider Senior Leadership Team in the Oryx Secondary school, to choose all subjects and academic pathways for their Sixth Form studies, which can extend across AS/A Levels or BTEC courses.

Mr Amaso, alongside the Secondary school Senior Leadership Team, then works to support the students with the demands of their chosen course subjects, and later on university entrance interviews; a responsibility that they each take very seriously. Which is why praise must be extended to the school's academic and examinations staff, for their wonderful work and support – which are the cornerstone of the students' success.

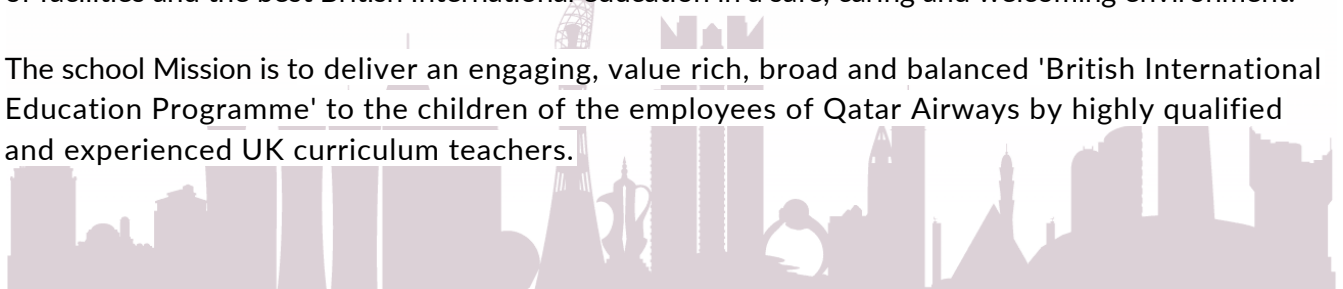
Oryx International School, opened its doors in 2016 and has since seen four graduating cohorts, the latest being the Class of 2025.
