Please note that Oryx International School does not provide branded swim-kits for students. Parents are simply requested to purchase garments in line with Ministry of Education & Higher Education (MoEHE) guidelines and circulars.

Students are encouraged to wear neutral colours, ideally black, but we appreciate that this is not always possible due to supply/demand from local retailers.

The school's school uniform provider, Noble House, do not stock swimming garments, so parents are recommended to visit local sports retailers.

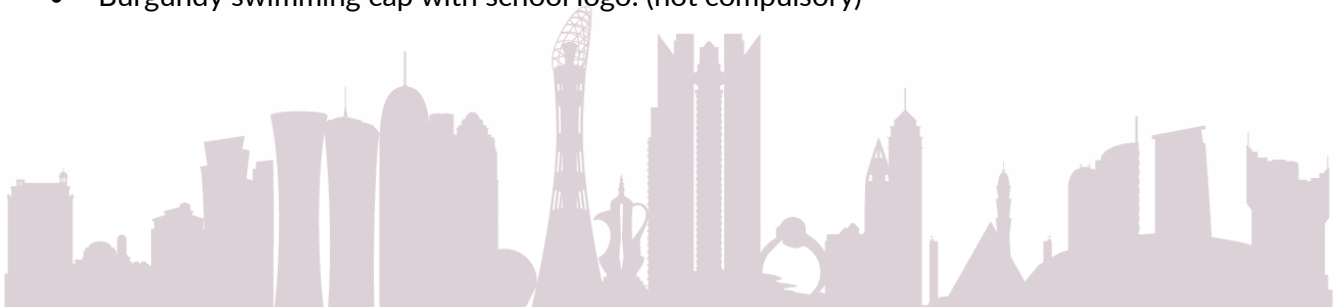
Swim kit Guidance as per MoEHE Circular 18

Boys - From Year 1 to Year 13

- Should wear a swimming costume that must be at least knee length
- There are no specifications regarding the need to cover shoulders
- The option is given to male students to wear a swimming top (all educational levels)
- Burgundy swimming cap with school logo. (not compulsory)

Girls - From Year 1 to Year 13

- Should wear a swimming costume that must be at least knee length
- Swimwear should adhere to the Qatari cultural sensitivities including ensuring that the costume has either long or short sleeves – IE shoulders should not be exposed
- Burgundy swimming cap with school logo. (not compulsory)





Illustrations

To assist understanding the guidelines, we have put together a selection of images to help illustrate types of acceptable clothing for swimming

Boys - From Year 1 to Year 13

A.) Long Shorts – covering the knee with or without a short sleeve top. One piece or separates



B.) Long sleeve top with a full-length trouser One piece or separates



Girls - From Year 1 to Year 13

B.) Short Sleeve Top with Long Shorts – covering the knee One piece or separates



B.) Long sleeve top with a full-length trouser OR Long Shorts with Skirt. One piece or separates





Please Note:

- Oryx International School is a mixed school (boys & girls) However, as per the MoEHE regulations, we do not mix between genders in swimming classes starting from the fourth grade of primary school and above.
- Burgundy swimming cap with school logo is not compulsory, but children with long hair are required to wear a swimming hat for H&S reasons
- When students participate in international sports competitions, they have the option of adhering to the specifications of sports clothing in accordance with the requirements of the competition and the organizing body, provided that the parent /guardian approves that (applicable to all education levels).
- Children who do not comply with the guidelines, will unfortunately not be able to attend school swimming lessons
